Silverton Doodles LLC – Purchase Agreement & Health Guarantee

Thank you for deciding to purchase a puppy from Silverton Doodles LLC. We strive to make this an enjoyable, stress-free experience. We are happy to answer your questions and provide updates as your puppy grows. This agreement is to protect both buyer and breeder, but especially the health and well-being of the puppy.

SECTION 1: Purchase Agreement

1. The buyer agrees to all contract terms by submitting a deposit.
 2. A \$500 deposit is required to hold the puppy of your choice. Puppy selection is on a first-come, first-served basis.
 3. Silverton Doodles reserves the right to cancel this agreement if we believe the puppy will not be adequately cared for. In such a case, the deposit will be fully refunded.
 4. Silverton Doodles provides accurate information on all dams and sires to the best of our knowledge.
 5. **Please ensure you are fully prepared for the time and financial responsibility** of raising a puppy before placing a deposit.

SECTION 2: Health Guarantee

6. The Breeder provides a two-year health guarantee against congenital and hereditary defects. If such a defect is diagnosed by a licensed veterinarian and supported by written documentation, the Buyer may return the puppy for a replacement puppy. This guarantee does not cover conditions resulting from injury, neglect, or improper care after the puppy leaves the Breeder's possession.

7. This guarantee is valid only if the Buyer has the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within seventy-two (72) hours of taking possession. Failure to complete this examination voids the health guarantee.
8. The breeder determines when a puppy is ready to go home, typically around 8 weeks of age. A \$10/day boarding fee applies for puppies kept longer than 8 weeks unless the delay is at the breeder's request.
9. Before pickup, all puppies are examined by a licensed veterinarian at Abiqua Animal Clinic and certified to be in good health at the time of examination.
10. Puppies will be up to date on vaccinations and deworming at the time of pick-up. The buyer is responsible for continuing care and ensuring the puppy completes its vaccination schedule within 16–20 weeks.
11. Do not expose the puppy to communal dog areas (e.g., parks, pet stores, doggy daycares) until all vaccinations are complete. If parvo or another disease is contracted before vaccination completion, it is not covered under this health guarantee.
12. The buyer must have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within 72 hours of receiving the puppy. A copy of the exam must be provided to the breeder within 10 days to validate the health guarantee.
13. If a licensed veterinarian finds the puppy unfit for sale within 72 hours and provides a written diagnosis, the puppy may be returned for a full refund if it has not been injured or neglected.
14. This guarantee does not cover common, minor issues such as colds, parasites (internal or external), Giardia, coccidia, or umbilical hernias. If there are any other known issues, they will be disclosed before the sale.

SECTION 3: Ownership & Buyer Responsibilities

15. Buyer agrees to pay the full balance before leaving with the puppy.
16. The breeder is not responsible for medical expenses after the puppy leaves our care.

17. The buyer assumes full responsibility for the puppy's care, safety, training, and socialization.
18. Professional training support is available via the AKC: [Puppy Training Timeline](#)
19. The breeder does not guarantee size, coat type, or color. Parent weights and coat traits will be disclosed; however, results may vary due to genetic and environmental factors.
20. This puppy is sold as a top-quality pet only. Breeding or show potential is not guaranteed.
21. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, the buyer agrees to have the puppy spayed or neutered by 12–18 months. This puppy may not be used for breeding purposes, whether accidental or for hobby use. The buyer will face a \$10,000 penalty and forfeiture of ownership rights if found in breach.
22. If the buyer can no longer keep the puppy, the buyer agrees to return the puppy to Silverton Doodles. Rehoming to vetted people is allowed.
23. If returned within 14 days (not due to health issues), 50% of the purchase price will be refunded after rehoming. After 14 days, no refund will be issued.
24. Silverton Doodles accepts returns of dogs at any age, though refund is not guaranteed. Our goal is to ensure that each dog has a safe and lifelong home.

SECTION 4: Photo & Marketing Release

25. Buyer grants permission for Silverton Doodles LLC to use photos or updates of the dog shared via email or social media for **marketing or educational purposes**.
